

Henry IV Part 2

Hal visits Falstaff, who is with Mistress Quickly at the Boars Head, whence they are summoned by the King, at war with the last of his rebels, including Scroop, Archbishop of York. Falstaff is to recruit soldiers, but lives off the hospitality of Shallow, a justice in Gloucestershire, and allows his recruits to buy their way out. The King's younger son, John and his army seize the Scroop and the other rebels, who are executed. The King, on his deathbed, is reconciled to Hal, who, as Henry V bars Falstaff on pain of death from approaching within ten miles of him.
