

Henry VI Part 3

York takes the throne, but Henry offers to rule for life, when the crown will pass to York. Margaret raises an army and defeats and kills York and one of his sons. His other sons, Edward, Richard and George, later defeat the King's army, and the victorious Yorkists crown Edward at Westminster. Henry is taken to the Tower and Margaret seeks aid in France. Edward's marriage to Lady Grey causes Warwick, also in France, to negotiate a marriage for Edward, to change his allegiance to Margaret, but he is killed in battle.
