Antipholus, a twin, is lost at sea with his mother, Amelia, and servant, Dromio. The father, Egeon, returns to Syracuse with his other son, also Antipholus, and servant, a twin also called Dromio. Antipholus leaves Syracuse with Dromio to seek their twins. Egeon comes to Ephesus, but is condemned to death as a citizen of Syracuse. Antipholus and Dromio arrive. Confusion ensues involving the wife of the other Antipholus, who had prospered in Ephesus, her sister, Luciana, a gold chain, arrest for debt, restraint for madness and refuge in the abbey. The abbess is Amelia and explains all. Egeon is reprieved.
